From Interstate 65 Northbound

Take the Muhammad Ali Boulevard Exit (Exit 136c) and travel five blocks to Fourth Street. Turn left on Fourth Street. The hotel is on your right.

From Interstate 65 Southbound

Take the Jefferson Street Exit (Exit 136c) and travel one block to First Street. Turn left on First Street, go two blocks, and then turn right on Muhammad Ali Boulevard. Drive four blocks on Muhammad Ali and then turn left on Fourth Street. The hotel will be on your right.

From Interstate 64 Westbound

Dr. Phillip J. Resnick, MD, is Professor of Psychiatry and Director, Division of Forensic Psychiatry at Case School of Medicine in Cleveland, Ohio. He has served as a consultant in many high profile cases including those of Jeffrey Dahmer, Susan Smith, Timothy McVeigh, Andrea Yates, Scott Peterson, William Kennedy Smith, and Theodore Kaczynski, the Unabomber. Dr. Resnick has served as President of the American Academy of Psychiatry and the Law and has published over 130 articles and book chapters. He will speaking to the KPMA on the topic, "**Risk Assessment for Violence.**"
